











4. WATER IN THE LANDSCAPE

› MEMORY GAME CARDS

 <p>Spring</p>	<p>The place where the river comes to the surface.</p>
 <p>River mouth</p>	<p>The place where the river flows into another river or sea.</p>
 <p>Erosion</p>	<p>Destruction and removal of part of the earth's surface.</p>
 <p>V shaped valley</p>	<p>The shape of the valley created by the river.</p>
 <p>Waterfall</p>	<p>A place where a river flows over a vertical drop or a series of steep drops.</p>
 <p>Debris slope</p>	<p>Degraded material that has been formed by weathering.</p>
 <p>Weathering</p>	<p>The breaking of rocks by frost, water and wind.</p>
 <p>Meander</p>	<p>River course deviation from the direction of flow.</p>
 <p>Delta</p>	<p>A branched river mouth with deposited material.</p>
 <p>Canyon</p>	<p>Deep and narrow valley.</p>
